## Contest Rules and Criteria (Regional and National levels)

- 1. The contest is open to all Grades IV to VI elementary pupils enrolled in any public and DepEd-accredited private elementary schools nationwide. Previous national winners are disqualified to join at any level of this contest. The regional contest will be conducted from August to September 2018.
- 2. The poster shall be an original creation of eligible participants, depicting the central theme of the World Food Day 2018 celebration, "Our Actions are our Future. A #Zero Hunger world by 2030 is possible."
- 3. Only the Best Five (5) Posters shall be selected as National Winners based on the following criteria:

a.	Originality	20%
	Creativity	
C.	Visual Impact	20%
d.	Relevance to the theme	40%

- 4. Materials to be used such as illustration board (20" x 30"), oil pastel color and pentel pen will be provided by the Regional On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest Committee during the contest. The theme should be incorporated on the poster as part of its design. A poster with no indicated theme shall be disqualified.
- 5. Theme should be hand written above and/or outside the art work and should take up no more than two & a half inches (2.5") for portrait and two inches (2") for landscape. (Please see attached sample)
- 6. The poster making contest shall be conducted on-the-spot in the Regional level. Judges and prizes will be determined by the Regional On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest Committee. However, Division/District level contest can be conducted provided that expenses to be incurred shall be shouldered by the DepEd or DA regional offices.
- 7. Only one (1) regional winning poster shall be the official entry of the region during the national judging, to be held at the DA-Central Office on October 3, 2018 at 10:00 a.m., AFID Conference Room. All entries must be received by the secretariat of the National On-the-Spot Poster Making Contest Committee on or before October 1, 2018 at 5:00 p.m.
- 8. Description of the poster entry must be written at the back of the poster with the name of the pupil, name of the school and region.
