The Bureau of Alternative Education (BAE) in coordination with the Bureau of Curriculum Development (BCD), and in partnership with the Asian Development Bank (ADB), developed the Contextualized Most Essential Learning Competencies (MELCs)-based Senior High School (SHS) Curriculum for Alternative Learning System (ALS). In preparation for the nationwide implementation of the ALS SHS curriculum and full implementation of the ALS K to 12 Basic Education Curriculum (BEC), the BAE will conduct the National Training of Education Program Specialists II for ALS (EPSA) on the Provision of Technical Assistance on the Implementation of the Contextualized MELCs-based SHS Curriculum for ALS with the following details:

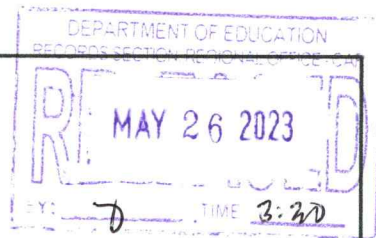
