REGIONAL STATISTICS QUIZ

To: All Schools Division Superintendents

1. In line with the celebration of the 26th National Statistics Month (NSM) this October and 2nd World Statistics Day (WSD) on October 20, 2015 and as stipulated in DepED Memorandum No. 104, s. 2015, the DepED-CAR will conduct a Regional Statistics Quiz at the Stephen N. Capuyan Hall on October 21, 2015 at 9:00AM.
2. The objective of the statistics quiz is to instill awareness and appreciation of the importance and value of statistics among students and teachers.
3. The participants will compose of:
 - a. Two (2) high school student-contestants to represent each of the Schools Division
 - b. One (1) Coach
 - c. Six (6) Quiz Committee Members from the Regional Office
 - d. Two (2) Consultants from the Regional Office
4. The following cash prizes will be awarded to winners by Division.
 - a. First Place - Php 3,000
 - b. Second Place - Php 2,000
 - c. Third Place - Php 1,000
 - d. Five (5) Consolation Prizes - Php 500 (non-winning team by Division)
5. Guidelines/Mechanics of the said Statistics Quiz is attached as Enclosure 1.
6. Transportation and other expenses of participants shall be charged to local funds, while AM snack and lunch during the statistical quiz shall be charged to Regional Office funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.

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GUIDELINES/MECHANICS OF THE REGIONAL STATISTICS QUIZ

1. Each school division shall be represented by two (2) high school student-contestants. Selection of division student-contestants shall be the prerogative of the Schools Division Office. It has the option to either merely appoint or conduct a division level quiz. Each contestant shall bring their school ID and should know their LRN (Learner Registration Number) for proper identification.
2. Each division shall have one (1) coach to accompany the student-contestants. Coaching shall only be done before the quiz proper. Coaches shall be seated far from the student-contestants to avoid them from coaching.
3.
 - a. The questions will be categorized into three: Easy, Moderate, and Difficult with five (5) questions per category.
 - b. The Quiz Master will read each question twice before the timer starts.
 - c. Contestants will be given 30 seconds to answer the Easy Type of questions, 45 seconds for Moderate, and 60 seconds for the Difficult Type of questions.
 - d. Each correct answer will be given the following points:
 - Easy questions - 1 point
 - Moderate questions - 2 points
 - Difficult questions - 3 points
 - e. In case of tie, clincher questions will be given until a winner is determined by the highest number of points. A clincher question will be given four (4) points.
 - f. Questions will include general information, basic educational statistics, and general statistics.
4. Other mechanics not specified in this Memorandum shall be agreed upon before the quiz proper.
5. Decisions of the Quiz Committee shall be final and non-appealable.
