**Short Story Film- making
Mechanics**

NCM Theme: "Healthy, Nourished, Sheltered: Ensuring the Right to Life for All."

I. Participants

- Participating in- school children should be from 12 – 17 years old to represent each provinces including Baguio City.
- Minimum of 5 participants, maximum of 8.
- One entry only per province and one for Baguio City.

- Other participating children are also from the residential facilities within Baguio City. **Confidentiality of children from the residential facilities will be highly observed.**

***Mentors/advisers are encouraged to support the entries of the children.**

II. Timeline

- Participants can start their film – making as early as they can within October, 2023.

III. Mechanics

- The participants will create a 5- 10 minutes short film.
- The film will focus on the theme **"Healthy, Nourished, Sheltered: Ensuring the Right to Life for All"** and to feature other rights and responsibilities of the children.
- The short film will be recorded through video format/MP4.
- Video and sounds must be clear.
- The story should have a beginning, middle, and ending part.
- Scripts are encouraged to be submitted with the video.

IV. Criteria

- 35% Relevance to the theme
- 25% Creativity
- 20% Clarity of video and sounds
- 20% Impact of message

V. Date of submission

- All entries are encouraged to be submitted **on or before November 17, 2023.**
- Entries will be emailed to rscwc_car@cw.gov.ph

VI. Date of judgement of entries

- Judging of entries will be on November 20, 2023.

VII. Date of Awarding

- Winners will be awarded on November 24, 2023 at Baguio City.
