

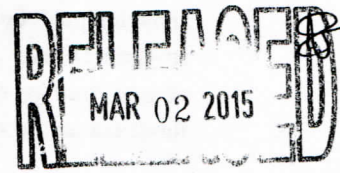

2. Travel of participants shall be on official business. The registration of Three Thousand Pesos (P3,000.00) and an additional One Thousand Pesos (Php 1,000.00), for fare per participant shall be paid by DepEd-CAR Regional Office. This amount will be downloaded to the Division Offices concerned. The transportation from the billeting place to the contest venues, training materials and other expenses relative to the travel shall be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations.

3. All coaches and contestants are required to bring the following documents:

a. For Contestants

- Certification by the school heads that the participant is a bonafide student enrolled in Public (General or Technical Vocational) or private high schools during the School Year 2014-2015.
- The school principal/school head shall certify that students are enrolled in the field of specialization where they are competing and participating.
- Photocopied school ID.
- Form 137

b. For Coaches

- Certification from the principal that the teacher is a bonafide staff of the school being represented.
- Certification from the principal of the teacher's designation as the adviser/coach of the student participant.
- Service Record
- School I.D.

4. Special Materials to be brought by the participants for **Industrial Arts** events are the following:

**A. Mini Cabinet Organizer**

Hinge	Wood Glue/Putty, Etc.	Hand Drill
Handle	Hand Tools	Brushes for Finishing
Nails	Power Sander	Extension Cord

NOTE:

1. No other power tools are allowed, except for the power sander and hand drill.
2. Other materials may be introduced in the final output.

**B. Film Designing and Printing Method**

Green Film	Prepared frame with screen
Paper	Tools/equipment needed for the designing and printing

NOTE:

1. Hand painting/retouching is not allowed. ALL prints should through the screen.
2. Only textile paints supplied by the organizer shall be used.

**Bazaar Exhibit**

1. All participating regions are required to display their best products and services (performances) before the opening program. However, the region will choose only one entry for each product and service to participate in the search for the most enterprising award. Each region shall assign two TLE/TVE students who are not participating in the skills exhibition to market their products/services within the exhibit booth area.
2. All products/services displayed in the Bazaar which are produced or rendered by TLE or TVE students as certified by the school head can be offered for sale, no items other than those mentioned earlier shall be displayed in the bazaar.
3. The points earned in the Bazaar Exhibit shall be included in the computation of over-all National Record Holders.


The criteria for judging the Bazaar Exhibits- the Most Enterprising Award shall be based on the following:

- Packaging of the product/service .....30%  
Originality and design - 15%  
Visual appeal/impact - 15%
- Marketability of the product/service ..... 30%  
(Appropriate pricing, taste, etc.)
- Communication skills and knowledge of the product/service ... .30%
- Gross sale of the product/service ..... 10%

Division coaches are requested to bring their best products in their respective schools/divisions to be included in the BAZAAR, for display and for sale.

Check-in shall be on **April 7, 2015** with lunch as the first meal, and check-out shall be on **April 10,2015** with a.m. snacks as the last meal.
