  - Group Writing Contests (Radio Broadcasting and Collaborative Desktop Publishing): first-₱7,000 for students and ₱3,000 for coach; second-₱5,500 for students and ₱2,500 for coach; third-₱4,000 for students and ₱2,000 for coach; fourth-₱2,500 for students and ₱1,500 for coach; fifth-₱2,000 for students and ₱1,000 for coach
