Subject: Regional Webinar on Alternative Learning Delivery Mode (ADM)

- 1. The DepEd is currently confronted with concerns on access to and quality of basic education due to the COVID-19 pandemic. Kinder to grade 12 classes were suspended and quarantine measures might extend until the first quarter of SY 2020 to 2021.
- 2. To prepare Supervisors, School Heads, and Teachers on handling classes should quarantine measures become extended, the Regional Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division in partnership with HRDD, QAD, and ICTU, proposed this *Webinar on Alternative Learning Delivery Mode*.
- 3. This upskilling activity was conceptualized as part of Project MAIDEN, to guide curriculum implementers in the SDOs and schools in the utilization of these Alternative Delivery Modes through distance or remote educational mechanisms. Since DepEd employees are on a work from home arrangement, this upskilling would utilize a webinar platform.
- 4. The general objective is to provide technical assistance on the utilization of alternative teaching and learning resources and delivery strategies as part of the implementation of Alternative Delivery Modes (ADMs). Specifically, the webinar shall:
 - a. enlighten the participants on the different Alternative Learning Delivery Modes (ADM) or mechanisms;
 - b. introduce the participants to distance or remote teaching mechanisms through online and offline strategies;
 - c. provide guidance to RO and SDO focal in designing and implementing online TA and monitoring mechanisms;
 - d. provide guidance to each school personnel in developing resources for online and offline distance or remote teaching.
