

FORMULATION OF THE CORDILLERA REGIONAL RECOVERY AND RESILIENCY PLAN FOR COVID 19

TO: Schools Division Superintendents
PDO II (DRRM)

1. Disaster rehabilitation and recovery is one of the thematic areas of disaster risk reduction and management. For the COVID 19 situation, rehabilitation and recovery overlaps with response activities in order to reduce the vulnerabilities of communities coping with the effects of the pandemic.
2. To address the effects of the pandemic, the Cordillera Regional DRRM Council (CRDRRMC) is on the process of preparing the Regional Recovery and Resiliency Plan with the following objectives:
 - a. assess the economic and social positive and negative effects and long-term impact of COVID-19 in CAR;
 - b. propose a region-specific recovery framework, strategies and prioritized PPAs; and
 - c. Formulate a Recovery and Resilience Plan consistent with national and regional plans, laws and guidance
3. A modified Post-Disaster Needs Analysis (PDNA) shall be utilized to gather baseline data needed for the Recovery and Resiliency Plan (RRP). Concerned offices shall furnish the Schools Division Project Development Officers for DRRM (PDO II-DRRM) the needed data for consolidation. Data needed are as follows:
 - a. Data on enrolment, number of schools, classrooms and personnel
 - b. Data on the number of computer units and internet access of schools
 - c. Economic losses
 - d. Recovery needs
4. Submission of data shall be on or before May 7, 2020. For reference on Post-Disaster Needs Analysis (PDNA), attached is the Guidance Note for Post-Disaster Assessment of the Education Sector.
