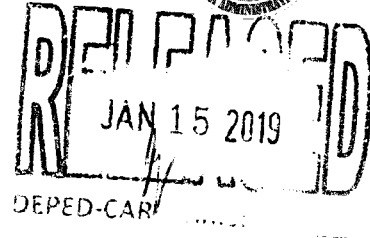

REGIONAL PARTICIPATION TO THE 2019 NATIONAL FESTIVAL OF TALENTS

TO : School Division Superintendents
Heads, Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools
All Divisions

1. Pursuant to DepEd Memorandum No. 168 s. 2018, the National Festival of Talents (NFOT) will be held in Dagupan City on January 28, 2019 to February 1, 2019 with the theme, *Celebrating Diversity through the Performance of Talents and Skills for Sustainable Inclusive Education*.
2. The 2019 NFOT aims to:
 - a. provide opportunity for learners from public and private elementary and secondary schools to showcase their talents and skills through exhibitions of their products, services and performance,
 - b. provide opportunity for teachers and learners to explore the culture of the host region.
3. The festival shall showcase talents and skills in the following areas:
 - a. Technolympics for Technology and Livelihood Education and Technical-Vocational-Livelihood,
 - b. Sining Tanghalan for Music and Arts,
 - c. Nationwide Song Writing and Choral Group Competition co-sponsored by DepEd and the Rotary Club of Manila,
 - d. National Population Development for Social Studies (Araling Panlipunan).
 - e. Pambansang Tagisan ng Talento for Filipino,
 - f. SPED (Sign Language and Braille), and
 - g. Musabaqah (Harf Touch and Arabic Spelling).
4. The names and number of official delegation for DepEd-CAR is indicated in Enclosure no. identified. *Official Delegation to the 2019 National Festival of Talents*.

5. There shall be no registration fee during the 2019 NFOT as specified in item number 6 of the DepEd Memorandum No. 168, s. 2018. Jackets to be used during the parade shall be borne by the Regional Office, however, traveling and miscellaneous expenses of participants going to and from the venue shall be charged to local funds or other sources, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

6. The Division Offices are tasked to make their own transportation arrangements. All participants are expected to be at the venue on January 28, 2019. The host region and the school's division shall provide meals in the billeting schools, kits, including identification tags, contest materials, and other related resources needed in the conduct of the 2019 Festival of Talents based on budget allocation as mentioned in the DepEd Memorandum 168, s. 2018. The first meal shall be served for lunch on January 28, 2019 while the last meal shall be the A.M. snacks on February 1, 2019.


