



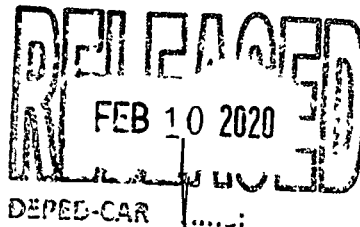

Validation Market Survey for Technical-Vocational Livelihood (TVL) Tools and Equipment

TO: Schools Division Superintendents
All Others Concerned

1. To come up with reasonable decision and recommendation in relation to the requests for termination by convenience submitted by RALCO Commercial Trading, APEX Multi-Purpose Cooperative and Songcuan Merchandising due to claimed non-availability of the TVL items in the market, DepEd-CAR Regional Office shall conduct a market survey to validate the said claim. Result of the survey will also serve as reference for future TVL-LTE procurement activities.
2. To fast track, the activity, Schools Division Offices (SDOs) through their Education Program Supervisor in-charge of Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE) are hereby requested to facilitate the conduct of the said market survey in their own division and adjacent provinces while the Regional Inspection Teams are advised do the survey within Region 1, Region 3 and Metro Manila from February 4-7, 2020. Scanned copies of the survey reports accurately accomplished shall be submitted to this office through clmd.depedcar@gmail.com copy furnish clemente.bandao@deped.gov.ph on or before February 10, 2020.
3. Attached is a validation form containing the list of TVL tools and equipment with specifications. Members of the Inspection Team shall put check mark on the corresponding column whether available or not. It is considered **"available"** only if an item meets all the specifications. Failure to meet one or more specification/s is considered **"not available"**. A space is provided at the bottom of the survey form for the respondent of the market survey to counter sign in attestation to the correctness of the entries.
