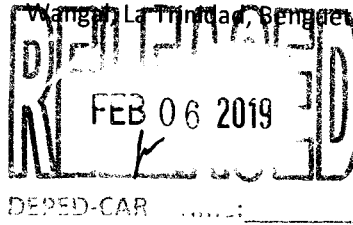

Planning and Training-Workshop on the Strengthening of Alternative Instructional Delivery Practices/Alternative Delivery Modes (ADMs)

1.
