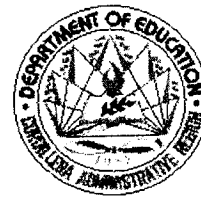




1. Relative to the implementation of the K to 12 and the implementation of the Regional IPEd Framework developed, there is a need to integrate IKSPs to the K to 12 competencies. 3. Attendance to this significant activity is highly expected from the Regional, Division Offices, and Council of Elders. Participants are the following:


