CONSTITUTION OF THE REGIONAL CHILD PROTECTION

**COUNCIL** 

- 1. In relation to the Consultation among DepEd CAR key persons on child protection concerns such as child abuse, bullying, CAR, and CICL (Regional Memorandum No. 110 s. 2016)conducted on April 29, 2016 where one of the objectives is the creation of a Regional Child Protection Committee, the participants agreed on the composition of the DepEd-CAR Regional Child Protection Council or DepEd-CAR RCPC.
- 2. The composition of the Regional Child Protection Council is agreed to be as follows:
  - a. The Officers
    - Regional Director as Chairperson
    - Assistant Regional Director as Co-Chairperson
    - Representative per Sector as Vice Chairpersons selected by the members of each sector
  - b. The Regular Members
    - The Legal Unit

    - All SDO representatives (7 per Division)
  - c. Honorary Members
    - LGU Representatives (per division)
    - RO DSWD Representative to be designated by the DSWD Regional Director, preferably the officer in charge of child protection
    - RO PNP Representative to be designated by the Regional Director
