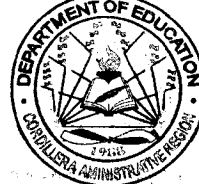

SUBJECT: **CONDUCT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION RESEARCH CARAVAN**

With the issuance of **DepEd Order No. 39, s. 2016, Adoption of the Basic Education Research Agenda**, the Policy, Planning, and Research Division (PPRD) will partner with the Policy Research and Development Division (PRD) to cascade the Basic Education Research Agenda to DepEd internal stakeholders, regional universities, and development partners. This agenda will provide guidance to DepEd and its stakeholders in the conduct of education research and in the utilization of research results to inform the Department's planning, policy, and program development aligned with its vision, mission, and core values. Furthermore, the Research Agenda shall build on gains from existing research, generate new knowledge on priority areas, focus DepEd's attention on relevant education issues, and maximize available resources for research within and outside the Department.

In line with this, we will be conducting a Research Agenda Orientation as part of the Nationwide DepEd Research Caravan on **July 22, 2016 8:00 AM – 5:00 PM at NEAPR Regional Office, Wangal La Trinidad, Benguet**. Specifically, this activity aims to:

- a. disseminate and promote the Basic Education Research Agenda to DepEd, external stakeholders, development partners, research institutions, higher education institutions (HEIs), teacher education institutions (TEIs), and other education partners interested in education research;
- b. strengthen existing partnerships and discuss new research collaborations based on the research agenda;
- c. develop a network of education research advocates in the region; and
- d. inform DepEd stakeholders on current national and regional research initiatives.

Attached as **Annex A** are the list of participants while **Annex B** details the indicative program of activities. Lodging and meals will be shouldered by the region while transportation and other incidental expenses shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations. First meal will be breakfast for the SDOs and selected schools participants and last meal will be PM Snack of July 22, 2016.
