The opening of classes for School Year 2016-2017 is scheduled on June 13, 2016. This also marks the start of the implementation of the additional 2 years in high school known as Senior High School (SHS) Program of the Department. Prior to the opening of classes, the Department developed and rolled-out the Electronic Class Program for SHS (E-Tool). The E-tool aims to guide school heads in developing their class programs and in determining their teacher requirements.

As the lead office, the School Effectiveness Division (SED) is tasked to collect data on the number of SHS School heads trained on E-tool. Said data will be used during the briefing for the incoming administration concerning our preparation for SHS implementation.
