Regional Participation to the Conduct of the National Training of Trainers (NTOT) on Kindergarten Pedagogies, Child-centered Approaches, DAP ELLN, and Classroom-based Assessment

1. Pursuant to the DepEd Order No. 47, s. 2016, Omnibus Policy on Kindergarten Education and RA 10157 on Kindergarten Education Act, under the provision of Continuous Professional Development for Teachers, and part of the Kindergarten Roadmap of Activities, the Bureau of Learning Delivery will conduct the National Training of Trainers for Teachers and Non-Teaching Personnel on Kindergarten Pedagogies, Child-Centered Approaches, DAP ELLN, and Classroom-Based Assessment.
