





1. In line with the celebration of the 27th National Statistics Month (NSM) and the 13th National Convention on Statistics and as stipulated in DepEd Memorandum No. 82, s. 2016, DepEd-CAR in partnership with Philippine Statistics Authority Regional Office will conduct a Regional Statistics Quiz at the NEAP-R Hall on October 20, 2016 at 8:30 AM onwards.
2. The objective of the statistics quiz is to instill awareness and appreciation of the importance and value of statistics among our students and teachers.
3. Each Schools Division shall conduct a Division Statistical Quiz to come up with their winners as participants to the Regional Statistics Quiz. Collaboration with the Philippine Statistics Authority Provincial Offices is highly recommended.
4. Participants shall be the top two (2) winners and one (1) coach for each Schools Division.

 - b. Second Place - Php 4,000

GUIDELINES/MECHANICS OF THE REGIONAL STATISTICS QUIZ

1. The contestants are the two (2) top winners from Grade 7 to Grade 11 and a coach in each Schools Division. Each contestant shall bring his/her school ID bearing his/her Learner registration Number (LRN).
2. Substitution is not allowed during the Quiz proper.
3. No cellphones, tablets, or any other electronic communication devices are allowed during the competition.
5. There will be three (3) components in the competition: Easy Round, Average Round and Difficult Round.
6. Questions will include general information, basic educational statistics and general statistics.
7. Each question will have the following sequence:
 - a. The quiz master will read the question projected on the screen twice. A timer will start after the quiz master says "GO".
 - b. Each team will raise their answer card after the quiz master will say "TIME IS UP" until the scores are properly recorded.
 - c. The quiz master will announce the correct answer for the questions. The assigned proctors will check each team's answer card to determine if their answer is correct or wrong. The proctor will raise a BLUE flag for a correct answer and a RED flag for a wrong or no answer at all.
8. In case of a tie, tie-breaker questions will be given until a winner is determined by the highest number of points. Each tie-breaker question will be given four (4) points.
9. Decisions of the Quiz Committee shall be final and non-appealable.

EASY ROUND:

1. There will be ten (10) multiple choice questions with four (4) options worth two (2) points for each question.
2. Each question is timed for ten (10) seconds.
3. The scores of each team will be totalled and carried over to the next round.

MODERATE ROUND:

1. There will be ten (10) multiple choice questions with four (4) options worth (3) points for each question.
2. Each question is timed for twenty (20) seconds.
3. The scores of each team will be totalled and carried over to the next round.

DIFFICULT ROUND:

1. There will be ten (10) multiple choice questions with four (4) options worth five (5) points for each question.
2. Each question is timed for thirty (30) seconds.
5. At the end of the Difficult Round, all scores will be summed up and the top three teams will be declared as the winners. The team with the highest number of points is automatically declared as the champion and the next teams as runner ups.
