

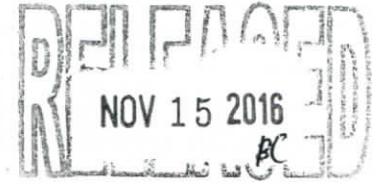

5. A one-day (1) service credit shall be granted to teacher participants while one day (COC) will be granted to the non-teaching personnel in lieu of December 11, 2016. Service credits and COCs shall be prepared by the division offices.
  
6. **A coordination and planning meeting of Regional Technolympics Contest Administrators, Regional & Division EPP/TLE/TVE Coordinators, Host Division representative and Host School principal is scheduled on December 1, 2016, 8 am to 5 pm at Rizal National School of Arts and Trades, Rizal, Kalinga.** Travel and other incidental expenses of the participants for the above coordination meeting will be charged to local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Twenty Five (25) pax for breakfast and Fifty (50) pax for lunch and two snacks shall be shouldered by the DepEd Regional Office.
