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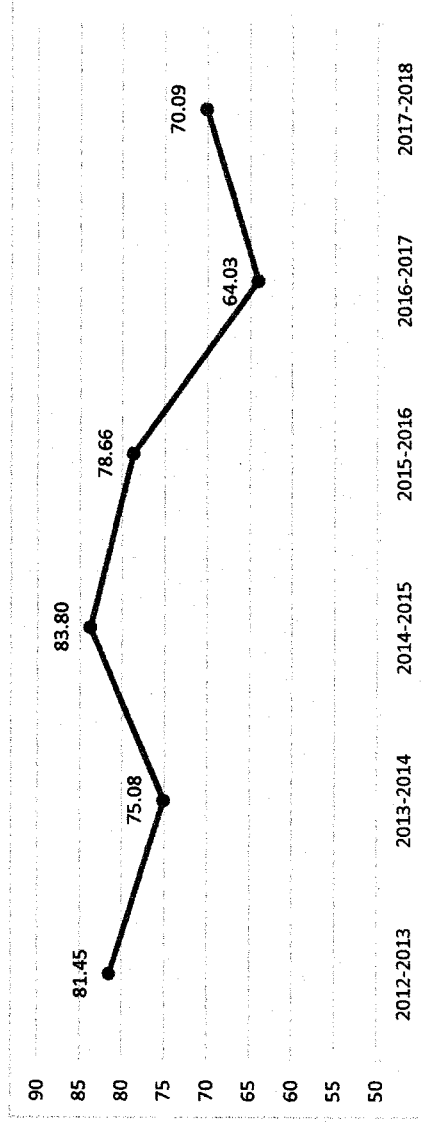

An erratic trend of the NIR was observed from SY2012-2013 to SY2014-2015 then continually declined reaching the lowest NIR ever recorded in the past six (6) school years at 64.03 in SY2016-2017. A very low NIR indicates a low measurement of access to grade 1 (age 6). It slightly recovered in SY2017-2018 by 6.06.

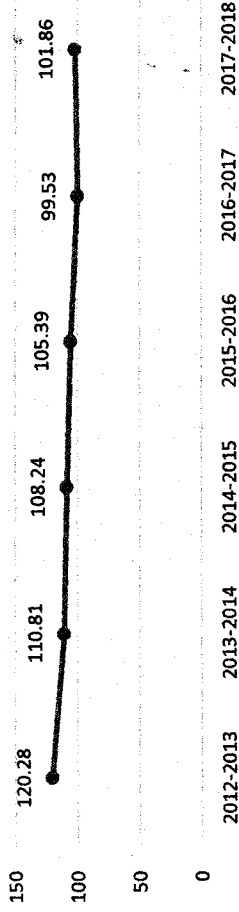
According to POPCEN 2015, there are 35,658 aged 6 children in the Region. NIR of 64.03 percent in SY 2016-2017 may account for 22,832 learners as enrolled in grade 1. This may imply that 12,826 learners are not enrolled in grade 1 in the same school year.



Baguio City consistently recorded the highest NIR for the past six (6) school years. This explains that Baguio City has a higher percentage of its aged 6 population that are enrolled in school as compared to the other Schools Divisions. Ifugao on the other hand consistently had the lowest mark except in SY2013-2014. In SY2017-2018, Ifugao hit its lowest NIR at 59.69 implying that only above 50 percent of its aged 6 population are in school.

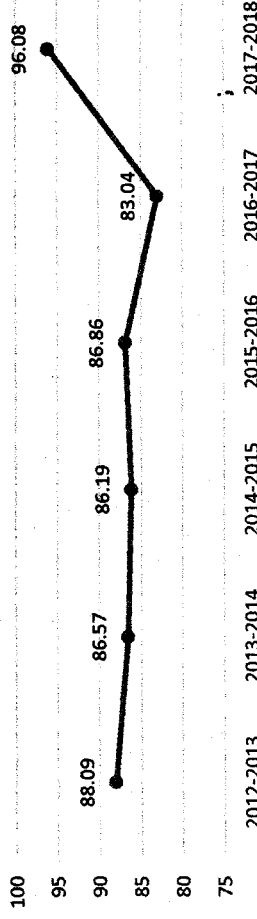

GER in the Elementary had been slightly declining for the past five SYs with a slight increase in SY2017-2018. Baguio City was consistent in towering the GER for the six school years. Benguet had the least GER for four (4) consecutive years from SY2013-2014 to SY 2016-2017 while Mt. Province was lowest in SY2012-2013 and SY2017-2018.

Almost all of the Schools Divisions had more than 100% GER which means that the school system was able to accommodate all children in the official age-group and also indicates that there are over-aged (above 11 years old) and/or under-aged (below 6) who were enrolled in school.

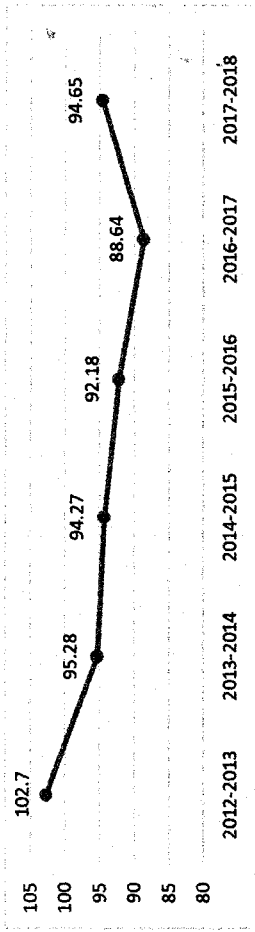
There was a decline in GER for the Secondary from SY 2012-2012 to SY 2016-2017 by 5.05 percent and had its peak in SY 2017-2018 at 96.08 indicating an increase of participation rate. Still, Baguio City had the record of getting the highest GER for the five school years and Mt. Province in SY2017-2018 with 131.89, while Ifugao consistently had the lowest GER for five years then Benguet in SY2017-2018. Still, there was a low level of participation in the secondary education.

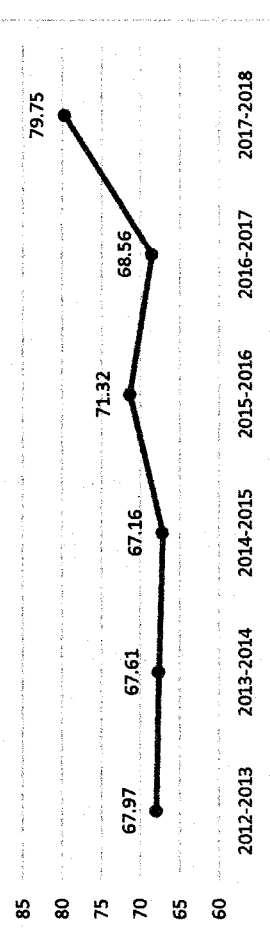


NER in the Elementary level steadily decreased in the past five SYs and recovered in SY2017-2018. Baguio City was recorded as having the highest NER for the six SYs reaching more than 100 percent. This conveys that there are more learners aged 6-11 who are enrolled in school than the registered population of the same age group in the area which maybe due to influx of learners from other provinces in CAR and other Regions.

As per POPCEN 2015, there is a total of 215,334 children aged 6-11 in CAR. NER of 88.64, the lowest recorded, comprises 190,872 learners enrolled in Elementary which means that 24,462 learners aged 6-11 or 11.36 percent may not have enrolled in school for SY2016-2017.

NER for the Secondary is lower as compared to the Elementary which may imply a lower enrollment in the Secondary. Again, Baguio City had the towering NER for the five school years and Mt. Province in SY2017-2018. Ifugao had the least for five SYs except in SY2017-2018 when Benguet registered the least.

There is a total of 141,341 aged 12-15 in the Region (POPCEN 2015). NER of 79.75 in the Secondary level for SY2017-2018 explains that 112,719 learners ages 12-15, were able to enroll. The 20.25 percent or 28,622 learners on the other hand were not in school.

Declining NER manifests that there is a low extent of participation of learners belonging to the official school age in both elementary and secondary education.

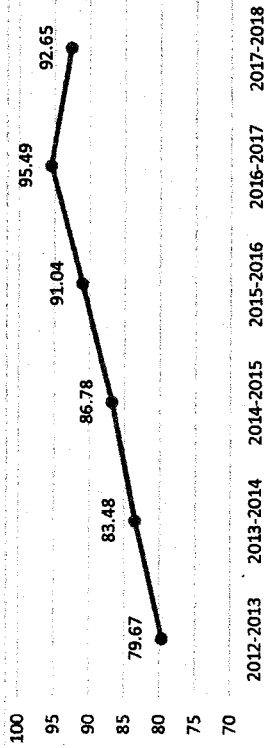

Elementary Cohort Survival Rate (CSR) is used to assess the internal efficiency and "wastage" in education. Data shows that CSR in the Elementary continually accelerated for the five school years having a total increase of 15.82. This implies that percentage of enrollees at the beginning grade (Grade 1) who reach the final grade (Grade 6) are escalating. It dropped however in SY2017-2018 by 2.97 percent.

The Schools Division getting the highest CSR is not specific since it changes each year. Kalinga however was observed to have appeared three (3) times as marking the lowest CSR specifically in SY2014-15, SY2016-17 and SY2017-18.

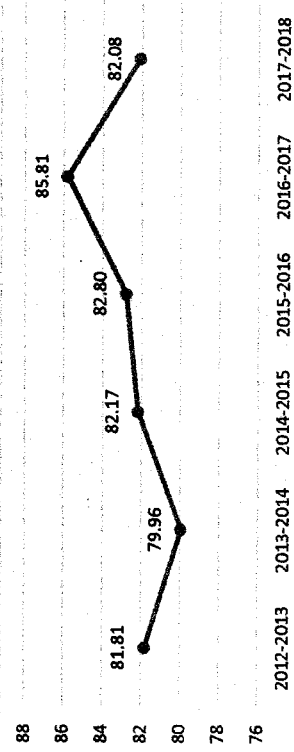

Secondary Cohort Survival Rate continually increased for the last four SYs but a higher Cohort Survival Rate was observed in the elementary level than in the secondary level starting SY2013-2014 to SY 2017-2018. This may imply that the Elementary level has a higher percentage of enrollees at the beginning grade who reached the final grade as compared to the Secondary level. Yet same with the Elementary, Secondary CSR dropped in SY2017-2018 by 3.73.

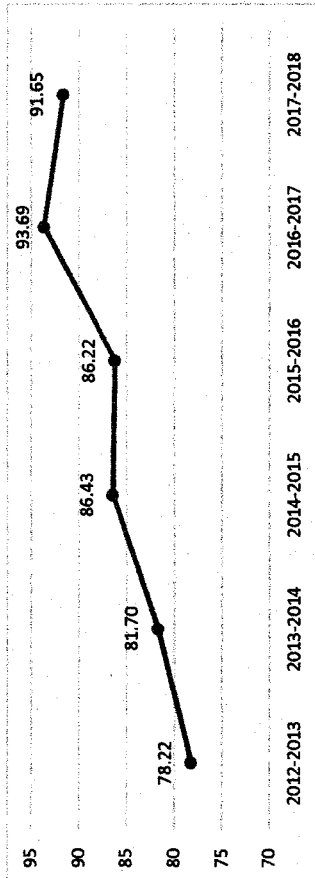
Likewise with the Secondary, the highest CSR is not consistent to any Schools Divisions but the lowest CSR as observed is Ifugao appearing three (3) times specifically in SY2013-14, SY 2015-16 and SY2016-17.

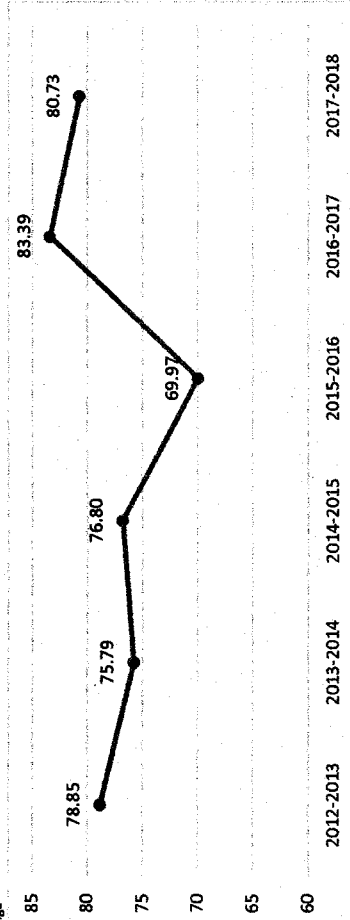
Completion Rate in the Elementary level veered upwards reaching its peak in SY2016-2017. Generally, elementary level registered a higher Completion Rate than the secondary level which means that there is a greater percentage of grade one entrants who graduate in elementary than there are grade 7 entrants who graduate in the secondary.

For the Secondary, the trend was downscaling but has recovered in SY2016-2017 with an increase of 13.42 from the last record.

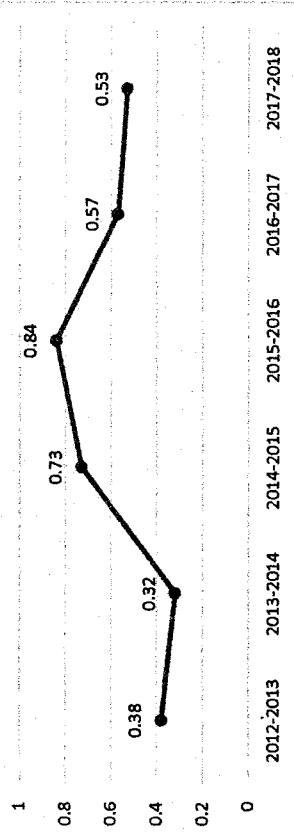
The declining of completion rate in the secondary level explains that the number of Grade 7 entrants who were able to graduate in secondary education are downsizing.

Dropout Rate (DR) in Elementary Schools had its peak in SY2015-2016 but is consistently lower than the Secondary dropout rate. In SY2017-2018, about one (1) out of 100 dropped out of school. Apayao is alarmingly recorded as having the highest dropout rate for the six (6) year span signifying that more learners are not finishing a particular grade before the school year ends.

Mt. Province on the other hand had the lowest for the six-year span implying that more learners are contained in school finishing a particular grade as compared to the other Schools Divisions.

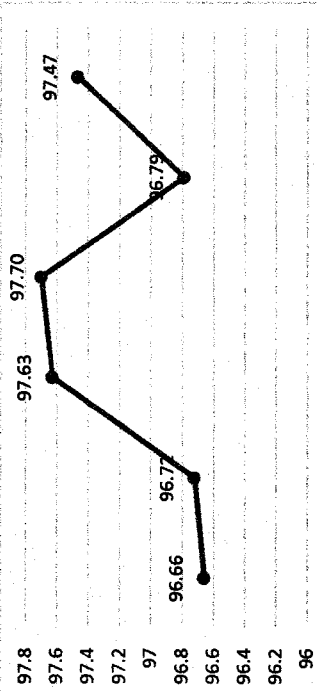
School leaver rate in the secondary level was observed to be declining for the past four SYs but jumped to 6.60 in SY2017-2018. These results show that averagely, seven (7) out of 100 students were at risk of leaving school. Alarmingly, there is a greater percentage of learners in the secondary level than in the elementary that leave school during the year and/or may have failed to enrol in the next school year.

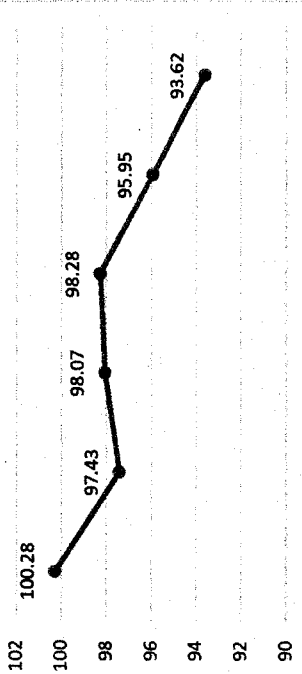
