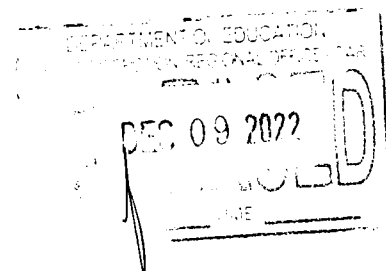

**CONDUCT OF THE PROJECT SIRIB PHASE 5: REVITALIZING VIRTUES AND VALUES IN EDUCATIONAL LEADERS (REVIVE)**

1. The Department of Education issued DepEd Order No. 42, s. 2017<sup>i</sup>, DepEd Order No. 24, s. 2020<sup>ii</sup>, and DepEd Order No. 25, s. 2020<sup>iii</sup> which emphasizes the crucial role of teachers and school leaders in nation building. The collaborative efforts are a realization of the goal to develop holistic learners and raising learners' achievement.

2. The goal of holistic and functional learners is also dependent to the quality of teachers and school leaders that provide the needed knowledge, skills and attitude. DepEd Order No. 1, s. 2020<sup>iv</sup> and DepEd Memorandum No. 50, s 2020<sup>v</sup> supports the realization of the Department's goals of continuous upskilling and reskilling of teachers and school leaders that will result in better learning outcomes.

3. Project SIRIB Phase 5: REVIVE emphasizes the need for a concrete picture of virtues, values and mental wellness of teachers and school leaders in achieving the goal for learners who shall serve as nation builders for the years to come.

4. The Phase 5 would like to address the following developmental priorities indicated in the Philippine Professional Standards for Teachers, School Heads and Supervisors as follows:

- a. PPST Domain 3.4 Special Topics on Increasing Adversity Quotient and Mental Health in the School Setting;
- b. PPSSH Domain 4.6 Identifying strengths, capabilities and potentials of individuals and teas in performing leadership roles and responsibilities; and,
- c. PPSS Domain 4.3 Reflecting on the Philippine Professional Standards for Supervisors to plan for personal and professional development goals

5. The Phase 5 shall be divided into three (3) Batches with particulars as follows:

Batch	Date	Modality
Batch 1: Instructional Leaders	January 11-13, 2023	Face to Face
Batch 2: School Heads & EPS II	January 18-20, 2023	Face to Face
Batch 3: SDO CID EPS & SEPS	February 8-10, 2023	Face to Face
Batch 4: SDO PSDS & RO EPS	February 15-17, 2023	Face to Face



6. The training shall compose of the following participants which will be nominated by the Schools Division Superintendent (SDS) in coordination with the Human Resource Unit. Nominees should meet the following criteria.

- a. Batch 1: Instructional Leaders (Total of 6 per SDO)
  - 1 Master Teacher for each Key Stage (1-4)
  - 2 Head Teachers who are not designated as school heads, preferably one from elementary and one from secondary
- b. Batch 2: School Heads (Total of 7 per SDO)
  - 3 SDO Philippine Elementary School Principal Association (PESPA) Officers preferably the topmost positions (President, Vice President and Secretary)
  - 3 SDO National Association of Philippine Secondary School Heads Incorporated (NAPSSHI) Officers preferably the topmost positions (President, Vice President and Secretary)
  - SDO HRDS Education Program Specialist II
- c. Batch 3: CID Education Program Supervisors (Total of 6 per SDO)
  - 5 Curriculum Implementation Division Supervisors
  - 1 HRDS Senior Education Program Specialist
- d. Batch 4: CID Public Schools District Supervisors (Total of 5 per SDO)
  - 5 Public Schools District Supervisors
  - All Regional Office Supervisors, Supervising Administrative Officers, and Project Development Officer IV

7. To facilitate and maximize the training session, each SDO HRDS Focal shall coordinate with the list of participants indicated in Enclosure 1 to register and confirm their participation through the link <https://tinyurl.com.P5ReviveReg>.
