- In reference to RM No. 614, s. 2025, titled Submission of Mentors and Program Facilitators for RTIP Cluster 1, this Office authorizes the participation of the identified participants listed in Enclosure 1 on September 22-26, 2025 at the NEAP Training Facility, Baguio City.
- through 2 All authorized participants are required register https://tinyurl.com/RTIPCluster1-Registration before September 12, 2025. In addition, laptops, chargers, extension cords, alternative sources of internet connectivity (e.g., mobile data, pocket Wi-Fi), and any necessary medication shall be brought ready for the activity.
- Check-in time is 3:00 PM of September 22, with dinner as the first meal while 3. checkout time shall be 12:00 noon of September 26, with PM snacks as the last meal. Those unable to arrive on Day 0 must ensure arrival at the training hall before 8:00 AM of September 23 in compliance with professional development standards.
- 4. Respective SDO RTIP Focals shall coordinate with the immediate supervisors of participants to implement necessary arrangements to ensure that participation in the program of personnel under their governance level will not cause class disruptions and hamper office operations.
- In cases of unforeseen circumstances wherein an identified participant cannot attend the scheduled activity, he/she is required to submit an explanation letter addressed to the SDO-SGOD Chief Education Supervisor. The letter shall facilitate the immediate processing of a replacement, in adherence to accountability and responsibility for the allotted training expenses per participant. The SDO-SGOD-SEPS shall then prepare a Division Memorandum to cover the replacement.


