

- 1. In reference to **DM-CT-2024-463** titled National Disability Inclusive Education Summit, this Office issues the **list of participants** for the aforementioned activity to be held at Baguio Teachers Camp, Baguio City on December 11-13, 2024.

 - d. build a collaborative network of stakeholders that leverages diverse expertise and resources in addressing challenges on inclusive education.

The Summit shall be participated by DepEd officials, instructional leaders, teachers, program partners/organizations, policymakers, and other stakeholders regarded as champions and advocates of disability inclusive education in the country.
