**2014 REGIONAL SEARCH FOR OUTSTANDING EDUKASYON
SA PAGPAPAKATAO (EsP) TEACHER**

To: All Schools Division Superintendents
Heads, Public Elementary & Secondary Schools

1. Pursuant to DepEd Advisory No. 332,s. 2014 on the 2014 Annual National Searches and National Competitions on Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao in celebration of the Values Month on November and on DepEd's commitment to recognize and motivate the efforts of the teachers, the Regional Office through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division will conduct the 2014 Regional Search for Outstanding Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP) Teacher.
2. The objectives of the search are to recognize the outstanding achievements of Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP) teachers and to encourage others in the field to uplift the quality of teaching EsP in the region.
Specifically, it aims to;
 - a. Motivate EsP teachers to excel in their field.
 - b. Encourage teachers to share best practices in teaching EsP.
 - c. Promote EsP as a vehicle for social transformation in Education.
3. All division winners with supporting documents shall be submitted to the Regional Office through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division on or before November 28, 2014. *(For the nomination form and the selection procedure of the search, please refer to DepEd Advisory No. 332, s. 2014).*
4. The pertinent documents of the winners (one winner from the elementary and one from the secondary level) in each schools division office shall be evaluated and validated by a structure committee composed of Education Program Supervisors and the chief of the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) as chairman in the Regional Office.
5. The top three winners for both the elementary and secondary levels will be declared as 2014 Outstanding Edukasyon sa Pagpapakatao (EsP) Teachers in CAR. They will be recognized during the Values Month Culminating Activity at NEAP-R, DepED, CAR, Wangal, La Trinidad, Benguet on December 5, 2014.
6. Transportation expenses of the participants shall be charged against local funds, while the one day accommodation and meals (breakfast and lunch) and two snacks shall be charged against Regional funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
7. Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is desired.
