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3. Travel and other incidental expenses of participants relative to the conduct of the activities shall be on official business and are chargeable to local funds subject to the usual accounting rules and regulations.
4. A registration fee of One Thousand Pesos (Php.1, 000.00) for elementary pupil participants and One Thousand Two Hundred Pesos. (Php.1, 200.00) for secondary student participants or elementary and secondary adult participants. This will cover the expenses for meals & snacks, board and lodging, some contest materials and operational expenses.
5. The first meal during the conduct of the 2016 Regional Technolympics will be lunch of February 18, 2016 and last meal will be dinner of February 20,2016.
6. A one-day (1) service credit shall be granted to teacher participants while one day (COC) will be granted to the non-teaching personnel in lieu of February 20, 2016. Service credits and COCs shall be prepared by the division offices.
